
AYA Scholarship

Regions

AYA has eight regions worldwide; six in North America, one in Europe, and one in Australia and New Zealand. There are over 30 Regional Directors and Area Coordinators serving members within these regions. Each region holds several events per year, and the numerous local area gatherings allow members to share common interests and information on topics such as maintenance and parts availability, mods, flying tips, and so on. Combined regional events and the Annual Convention include seminars and guest speakers, and are well attended.

American Yankee Association: Pilot Familiarization Program

The PFP gives new Grumman owners a comprehensive checkout in their new airplane from a Grumman-experienced CFI.

While Grummans aren't inherently more difficult to fly than other types, they have a number of unique characteristics and handling qualities that make a thorough checkout from a qualified instructor more than just a good idea. In fact, completing a PFP checkout makes some new Grumman pilots eligible for insurance discounts through the AYA Insurance Program in the USA.

The PFP is a "Train-to Proficiency" program, and as such, does not require any specified number of hours. Time to complete will depend on the individual pilot's background, experience, and current proficiency.

AYA Insurance Program

AYA, through Aircraft and Marine Assurance Agency, Inc., has a group insurance policy in the USA which covers both aircraft hull and liability risks. We have established an excellent safety record over the years, which results in a very competitive premium.
